



FIRETEX® M90/02 PROTECTS OIL AND GAS FIELD DEVELOPMENT

The Johan Castberg Floating Production Storage and Offloading (FPSO) topsides and process modules project - which is owned by Equinor, designed by Aker Solutions AS and being constructed by Kvaerner AS - consists of the development of three fields Skrugard, Havis and Drivis in the Barents Sea located approximately 240 km from Hammerfest in Norway.

The water depth is approximately 380 m. The FPSO is a self-contained unit including living quarters and with all necessary process, utility and hull systems for operation in a harsh Barents Sea environment. The FPSO will be permanently moored by means of an internal turret mooring system.

THE FIELD'S PRODUCTION CAPACITY IS EXPECTED TO BE 200,000 BARRELS OF OIL EQUIVALENT PER DAY OVER AN ESTIMATED OPERATIONAL LIFE OF 30 YEARS.
